# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

**MR. SPEAKER:**

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 177 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 2, between lines 16 and 17, begin a new paragraph and
- 2 insert:
- 3 "SECTION 3. IC 14-13-3-4, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-1995,
- 4 SECTION 6, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 5 JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 4. (a) The commission consists of the following
- 6 members:
- 7 (1) The executive of Gary.
- 8 (2) The executive of Hammond.
- 9 (3) The executive of East Chicago.
- 10 (4) The executive of Portage.
- 11 (5) The executive of Michigan City.
- 12 (6) The executive of Whiting.
- 13 (7) The director of the department of commerce, who is a
- 14 nonvoting member.
- 15 (8) The director of the department, who is a nonvoting member.
- 16 **(9) Three (3) members of the general assembly, who are**
- 17 **nonvoting members appointed under section 5.5 of this**
- 18 **chapter.**
- 19 (b) A member of the commission may designate an individual to
- 20 serve on the commission in the member's place.
- 21 SECTION 4. IC 14-13-3-5.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
- 22 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 23 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: **Sec. 5.5. (a) The members appointed**
- 24 **from the general assembly under section 4(a)(9) of this chapter are**

- 1 as follows:
- 2 (1) A member who resides in Lake County.
- 3 (2) A member who resides in LaPorte County.
- 4 (3) A member who resides in Porter County.
- 5 (b) Not more than two (2) members appointed under section
- 6 4(a)(9) of this chapter may be of:
- 7 (1) the same political party; or
- 8 (2) the same chamber of the general assembly.
- 9 (c) The governor shall annually make the appointments
- 10 required under section 4(a)(9) of this chapter.
- 11 (d) If a member of the general assembly appointed under
- 12 section 4(a)(9) of this chapter ceases to be a member of the general
- 13 assembly, the member also ceases to be a member of the
- 14 commission, creating a vacancy for the duration of the member's
- 15 term.
- 16 (e) If a vacancy exists under subsection (d), the governor shall
- 17 appoint a member of the general assembly to fill the vacancy for
- 18 the duration of the former member's term. A member appointed
- 19 under this subsection must have the same qualifications as the
- 20 former member whose position has become vacant.
- 21 SECTION 5. IC 14-13-3-6, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-1995,
- 22 SECTION 6, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 23 JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 6. (a) **Except as provided in subsection (c),**
- 24 members of the commission are not entitled to receive from the
- 25 commission a per diem. However, the members are entitled to receive
- 26 an amount for mileage or travel.
- 27 (b) Designees:
- 28 (1) of members of the commission; and
- 29 (2) who are not holders of public office;
- 30 are entitled to receive from the commission an amount for per diem,
- 31 mileage, and travel allowance equal to that fixed by the budget agency
- 32 as payment to all persons entitled to receive those payments from the
- 33 state.
- 34 (c) **A member appointed under section 4(a)(9) of this chapter**
- 35 **is entitled to receive the same per diem, mileage, and travel**
- 36 **allowances paid to members of the general assembly serving on**
- 37 **interim study committees established by the legislative council."**
- 38 Page 5, after line 18, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 39 "SECTION 9. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **The**
- 40 **appointments made by the governor under IC 14-13-3-4(a)(9), as**
- 41 **amended by this act, must be made not later than June 30, 1998.**
- 42 (b) **This SECTION expires July 1, 1998.**
- 43 SECTION 10. **An emergency is declared for this act."**
- 44 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
