MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1001 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between lines 13 and 14, begin a new paragraph and
- 2 insert:
- 3 **"(d) Notwithstanding IC 6-8.1-7 or any other provision of law**
- 4 **prohibiting disclosure of a taxpayer's records or information, all**
- 5 **information exchanged among the department of revenue, the**
- 6 **claimant agency (as defined in IC 6-8.1-9.5-1), and the taxpayer**
- 7 **who is an obligor with a child support arrearage necessary to**
- 8 **accomplish the purpose of this SECTION is lawful.**
- 9 **(e) Whenever the child support bureau of the division of family**
- 10 **and children seeks to enforce a child support obligation through a**
- 11 **setoff against an obligor's rebate under this SECTION, the**
- 12 **department of revenue shall make the following information**
- 13 **available to that agency and to any other state's Title IV-D agency**
- 14 **that is enforcing the child support order against the obligor:**
- 15 **(1) The obligor's Social Security account number (or**
- 16 **numbers, if the obligor has more than one (1) number).**
- 17 **(2) The obligor's home address.**
- 18 **(f) The child support bureau of the division of family and**
- 19 **children and its agents and any other state's Title IV-D agency are**
- 20 **entitled to intercept an obligor's rebate under this SECTION for**
- 21 **the purpose of enforcing a child support obligation of an obligor**
- 22 **who has a child support arrearage."**
- 23 Page 1, line 14, delete "(d)" and insert "(g)".
- 24 Page 1, line 16, delete "(e)" and insert "(h)".
