HOUSE MOTION _____

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1119 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
- 2 paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 1. IC 9-24-2-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.132-1995,
- 4 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 5 JANUARY 1, 1999]: Sec. 1. (a) A driver's license or a learner's permit
- 6 may not be issued to an individual less than eighteen (18) years of age
- 7 who meets any of the following conditions:
- 8 (1) Is a habitual truant under IC 20-8.1-3-17.2.
- 9 (2) Is under at least a second suspension from school for the
- 10 school year under IC 20-8.1-5.1-8 or IC 20-8.1-5.1-9.
- 11 (3) Is under an expulsion from school under IC 20-8.1-5.1-8,
- 12 IC 20-8.1-5.1-9, or IC 20-8.1-5.1-10.
- 13 (4) Has withdrawn from school, for a reason other than financial
- 14 hardship and the withdrawal was reported under
- 15 IC 20-8.1-3-24(a) before graduating.
- 16 **(5) Has a grade point average of less than C (or the numeric**
- 17 **equivalent), unless the individual received a passing score on**
- 18 **the most recent ISTEP test under IC 20-10.1-16 that the**
- 19 **individual was required to take.**
- 20 (b) At least five (5) days before holding an exit interview under
- 21 IC 20-8.1-3-17(b)(2), the school corporation shall give notice by
- 22 certified mail or personal delivery to the student, the student's parent,
- 23 or the student's guardian of the following:
- 24 (1) That the exit interview will include a hearing to determine if

1 the reason for the student's withdrawal is financial hardship.
 2 (2) If the principal determines that the reason for the student's
 3 withdrawal is not financial hardship:
 4 (A) the student and the student's parent or guardian will
 5 receive a copy of the determination; and
 6 (B) the student's name will be submitted to the bureau for
 7 the bureau's use in denying or invalidating a driver's license
 8 or learner's permit under this section.
 9 SECTION 2. IC 9-24-9-7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 10 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
 11 1, 1998]: **Sec. 7. An individual less than eighteen (18) years of age**
 12 **who applies for a permit or license under this chapter must submit**
 13 **with the application:**
 14 (1) a certified copy of the individual's school transcript; and
 15 (2) if the transcript shows that the individual has a grade
 16 point average of less than C (or the numeric equivalent), a
 17 certified copy from the individual's school corporation
 18 showing that the individual received a passing score on the
 19 most recent ISTEP test under IC 20-10.1-16 that the
 20 individual was required to take."
 21 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
