MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1119 be amended to read as follows:

1 Page 4, after line 29, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 3. IC 20-8.1-4-12 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 12. (a) Upon
4 presentation of the documents required by section 7 of this chapter **and**
5 **if the child has a grade point average of C or higher (or the**
6 **numeric equivalent) for the most recent grading period before the**
7 **date the child wishes to receive an employment certificate,** an
8 employment certificate shall be issued immediately to the child.
9 However, an issuing officer may deny a certificate to a child
10 (1) whose attendance is not in good standing. ~~or~~
11 (2) whose academic performance does not meet the school
12 corporation's standard.
13 (b) Within five (5) days, the issuing officer shall send a copy of the
14 employment certificate to the department of labor. The issuing officer
15 shall keep a record in his office of each employment certificate issued.
16 (c) A student may appeal the denial of a certificate under
17 subsection (a) to the school principal.
18 SECTION 4. IC 20-8.1-4-32 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
19 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 32. (a) An employment
20 certificate issued under this chapter ~~may~~ **must** be revoked by the
21 issuing officer if the issuing officer determines that ~~there has been a~~
22 **significant decrease in any of the following** since the issuance of the
23 permit **at least one (1) of the following has occurred:**

- 1 (1) The student's grade point average **for a grading period is**
2 **not C or higher (or the numeric equivalent).**
- 3 (2) **A significant decrease in** the student's attendance at school
4 **has occurred.**
- 5 (b) A student whose employment certificate is revoked under
6 subsection (a) is entitled to a periodic review of the student's grade
7 record or attendance record, or both, to determine whether the
8 revocation should continue. A periodic review may not be conducted
9 less than one (1) time each school year.
- 10 (c) If upon review the issuing officer determines that:
- 11 (1) the student's grade point average **is C or higher (or the**
12 **numeric equivalent);** or
- 13 (2) **the student's grade point average is C or higher (or the**
14 **numeric equivalent) and the student's attendance or both, have**
15 **has improved substantially;**
- 16 the issuing officer may reissue an employment certificate to the
17 student.
- 18 (d) A student may appeal the revocation of an employment
19 certificate under subsection (a) or the refusal to reissue an employment
20 certificate under subsection (c) to the school principal.
- 21 (e) An issuing officer who revokes an employment certificate shall
22 immediately send written notice of the revocation to the child's
23 employer.".
