MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 104 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
2 paragraph and insert:
3 "SECTION 1. IC 9-21-5-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
4 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 2. Except when a
5 special hazard exists that requires lower speed for compliance with
6 section 1 of this chapter, the slower speed limit specified in this section
7 or established as authorized by section 3 of this chapter is the
8 maximum lawful speed. A person may not drive a vehicle on a highway
9 at a speed in excess of the following maximum limits:
10 (1) Thirty (30) miles per hour in an urban district.
11 (2) Fifty-five (55) miles per hour, except as provided in
12 subdivisions (1), (3), and (4).
13 (3) ~~Sixty-five (65)~~ **Seventy (70)** miles per hour on a highway on
14 the national system of interstate and defense highways located
15 outside of an urbanized area (as defined in 23 U.S.C. 101) with
16 a population of at least fifty thousand (50,000), except as
17 provided in subdivision (4).
18 (4) Sixty (60) miles per hour for a vehicle (other than a bus)
19 having a declared gross weight greater than twenty-six thousand
20 (26,000) pounds on a highway on the national system of
21 interstate and defense highways located outside an urbanized
22 area (as defined in 23 U.S.C. 101) with a population of at least
23 fifty thousand (50,000).
24 (5) Fifteen (15) miles per hour in an alley."
25 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
