MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1074 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 2, after line 8, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 2. IC 14-22-12-1, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-1995,
- 3 SECTION 15, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS: Sec. 1. The
- 4 department may issue the following licenses and shall charge the
- 5 following license fees to hunt, trap, or fish in Indiana:
- 6 (1) A resident yearly license to fish, eight dollars and
- 7 seventy-five cents (\$8.75).
- 8 (2) A resident yearly license to hunt, eight dollars and
- 9 seventy-five cents (\$8.75).
- 10 (3) A resident yearly license to hunt and fish, thirteen dollars and
- 11 seventy-five cents (\$13.75).
- 12 (4) A resident yearly license to trap, eight dollars and
- 13 seventy-five cents (\$8.75).
- 14 (5) A nonresident yearly license to fish, fifteen dollars and
- 15 seventy-five cents (\$15.75).
- 16 (6) A nonresident yearly license to hunt, forty dollars and
- 17 seventy-five cents (\$40.75).
- 18 (7) A nonresident yearly license to trap, seventy-six dollars and
- 19 seventy-five cents (\$76.75). However, a license may not be
- 20 issued to a resident of another state if that state does not give
- 21 reciprocity rights to Indiana residents similar to those
- 22 nonresident trapping privileges extended in Indiana.
- 23 (8) A resident or nonresident license to fish, including for trout
- 24 and salmon, for one (1) day only, four dollars and seventy-five
- 25 cents (\$4.75).
- 26 (9) A nonresident license to fish, excluding for trout and salmon,

- 1 as follows:
- 2 (A) For three (3) days only, six dollars and seventy-five
- 3 cents (\$6.75).
- 4 (B) For seven (7) days only, eight dollars and seventy-five
- 5 cents (\$8.75).
- 6 (10) A nonresident license to hunt for five (5) consecutive days
- 7 only, thirteen dollars and seventy-five cents (\$13.75).
- 8 (11) A resident or nonresident yearly stamp to fish for trout and
- 9 salmon, six dollars and seventy-five cents (\$6.75).
- 10 (12) A resident yearly license to take a deer with a shotgun,
- 11 muzzle loading gun, or handgun, thirteen dollars and
- 12 seventy-five cents (\$13.75).
- 13 (13) A resident yearly license to take a deer with a muzzle
- 14 loading gun, thirteen dollars and seventy-five cents (\$13.75).
- 15 (14) A resident yearly license to take a deer with a bow and
- 16 arrow, thirteen dollars and seventy-five cents (\$13.75).
- 17 (15) A nonresident yearly license to take a deer with a shotgun,
- 18 muzzle loading gun, or handgun, seventy-six dollars and
- 19 seventy-five cents (\$76.75).
- 20 (16) A nonresident yearly license to take deer with a muzzle
- 21 loading gun, seventy-six dollars and seventy-five cents (\$76.75).
- 22 (17) A nonresident yearly license to take a deer with a bow and
- 23 arrow, seventy-six dollars and seventy-five cents (\$76.75).
- 24 (18) A resident license to take an extra deer by a means, in a
- 25 location, and under conditions established by rule adopted by the
- 26 department, thirteen dollars and seventy-five cents (\$13.75).
- 27 (19) A nonresident license to take an extra deer by a means, in
- 28 a location, and under conditions established by rule adopted by
- 29 the department, seventy-six dollars and seventy-five cents
- 30 (\$76.75).
- 31 (20) A resident yearly license to take a turkey, fourteen dollars
- 32 and seventy-five cents (\$14.75).
- 33 **(21) A resident license to take an extra turkey by a means,**
- 34 **in a location, and under conditions established by rule**
- 35 **adopted by the department, fourteen dollars and seventy-**
- 36 **five cents (\$14.75).**
- 37 ~~(21)~~ **(22)** A nonresident yearly license to take a turkey,
- 38 seventy-six dollars and seventy-five cents (\$76.75). However, if
- 39 the state of residence of the nonresident applicant requires that
- 40 before a resident of Indiana may take turkey in that state the
- 41 resident of Indiana must also purchase another license in
- 42 addition to a nonresident license to take turkey, the applicant
- 43 must also purchase a nonresident yearly license to hunt under
- 44 this section.
- 45 ~~(22)~~ **(23)** A resident youth yearly consolidated license to hunt,
- 46 six dollars (\$6). This license is subject to the following:
- 47 (A) An applicant must be less than eighteen (18) years of
- 48 age.
- 49 (B) The license is in lieu of the resident yearly license to
- 50 hunt and all other yearly licenses, stamps, or permits to hunt
- 51 for a specific species or by a specific means.
