DIGEST OF HB1106 (Updated January 21, 1998 5:31 pm - DI 76)

Citations Affected: IC 22-14-2-12.

Synopsis: Children's camp for fire or explosion victims. Allows the office of the state fire marshal to develop and implement or participate in the development and implementation of a camp or camping program for children who are less than 19 years of age and have suffered burns or other physical trauma as a result of a fire or an explosion. Allows the office to provide staff assistance for developing and implementing a camp or camping program. Allows the state fire marshal or designee of the state fire marshal to serve as a director of a nonprofit corporation organized to develop or implement a camp or camping program.

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HOUSE BILL No. 1106

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning labor and industrial safety.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 22-14-2-12 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 12. (a) The office may develop and
4 implement or participate in the development and implementation
5 of a camp or camping program for children who:
6 (1) are less than nineteen (19) years of age; and
7 (2) have suffered burns or other physical trauma as a result
8 of a fire or an explosion.
9 (b) The office may provide staff assistance for developing and
10 implementing a camp or camping program under this section.
11 (c) The state fire marshal may enter into one (1) or more
12 contracts, including joint venture agreements and cooperative
13 agreements, to carry out this section.
14 (d) The state fire marshal or a designee of the state fire marshal
15 may serve as a director or an officer of a nonprofit Indiana**

3 **(e) The office may do the following to implement this section:**
