Citations Affected: IC 20-12.

Synopsis: Indiana laboratory school for the arts. Allows Indiana University to establish a public, residential high school for the arts beginning in the 1998-1999 school year.

Effective: July 1, 1998.

HOUSE BILL No. 1109

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 20-12-14.6 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 1998]:
4 **Chapter 14.6. Indiana School for the Arts**
5 **Sec. 1. Beginning in the 1998-1999 school year, Indiana**
6 **University may establish the Indiana school for the arts under**
7 **IC 20-12-14.**
8 **Sec. 2. The school shall operate:**
9 (1) a public, residential school for high school students in
10 Indiana; and
11 (2) a program for public or nonpublic school educators.
12 **Sec. 3. A student who applies for admission to the school must:**
13 (1) be eligible to attend a public school in Indiana;
14 (2) demonstrate exceptional ability;
15 (3) demonstrate a commitment to scholarship; and
16 (4) demonstrate a commitment to the arts.
17 **Sec. 4. The school shall:**

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- 1 **(1) establish an advisory committee that represents the**
- 2 **education and the arts communities in Indiana;**
- 3 **(2) determine the standards for admissions and the curricula**
- 4 **and courses of study to be offered;**
- 5 **(3) develop curriculum material for distribution and use**
- 6 **throughout the public school system;**
- 7 **(4) develop programs to encourage interaction with public or**
- 8 **nonpublic school educators;**
- 9 **(5) make curriculum material available to students in public**
- 10 **schools throughout Indiana by the use of telecommunications**
- 11 **technology; and**
- 12 **(6) establish cooperative arrangements with private and**
- 13 **public entities in order to effectively operate the school.**
