DIGEST OF HB 1145 (Updated January 28, 1998 6:18 pm - DI 93)

Citations Affected: IC 9-13; IC 9-18.

Synopsis: Special group license plates. Allows a license plate for an antique motor vehicle to indicate the year in which the motor vehicle was manufactured if the vehicle is at least 25 years old. Requires the bureau to issue an Indiana retired armed forces member license plate. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles to adopt rules establishing the classification of antique car museum dealer license plates. Allows a person who has served at least 20 years in the United States Armed Forces or their reserves and qualifies for a paid retirement to receive an Indiana retired armed forces member license plate. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles (bureau) to issue a drug free Indiana trust license plate. Requires the additional fee required for the drug free Indiana trust license plate to be deposited in a special account and distributed to Drug-Free Youth, Inc. Requires the bureau to issue an Indiana FFA trust license plate. Requires the additional fee required for the Indiana (Continued next page)

FFA trust license plate to be deposited in the Indiana FFA trust fund and distributed to the Indiana FFA foundation. Requires the bureau to issue an Indiana firefighter license plate for which an Indiana firefighter is eligible. Requires the bureau to issue an Indiana food bank trust license plate. Requires the additional fee required for the Indiana food bank trust license plate to be deposited in the Indiana food bank trust fund and distributed to the food bank serving the county in which the vehicle is registered. Requires the bureau to issue an Indiana girl scouts trust license plate. Requires the additional fee required for the Indiana girl scouts trust license plate to be deposited in the Indiana girl scouts trust fund and distributed to the council of the Girl Scouts of America located in the county in which the vehicle is registered. Requires the bureau to issue an Indiana boy scouts trust license plate. Requires the additional fee required for the Indiana boy scouts trust license plate to be deposited in the Indiana boy scouts trust fund and distributed to the council of the Boy Scouts of America located in the county in which the vehicle is registered. Requires the bureau to issue an Indiana state parks license plate. Requires the additional fee required for the Indiana state parks license plate to be deposited in the state parks special revenue fund. Requires the bureau to issue a D.A.R.E. license plate. Requires the additional fee required for the D.A.R.E. plate to be deposited in the D.A.R.E. Indiana trust fund and distributed to D.A.R.E. Indiana. Requires the bureau to issue an Indiana antique car museum trust license plate. Requires the additional fee required for the Indiana antique car museum trust plate to be deposited in Indiana antique car museum trust fund and distributed to the Association of Antique Car Museums of Indiana. Specifies that an individual eligible to receive certain license plates is also eligible to apply for a personalized license plate.

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HOUSE BILL No. 1145

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 9-13-2-77.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: **Sec. 77.5. "Indiana firefighter", for**
4 **purposes of IC 9-18-34, has the meaning set forth in IC 9-18-34-1.**
5 SECTION 2. IC 9-18-12-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
6 FOLLOWS: Sec. 2. (a) The bureau shall issue one (1) license plate to
7 the person who owns an antique motor vehicle that is registered under
8 this chapter.
9 (b) A license plate for an antique motor vehicle shall be:
10 (1) manufactured of embossed steel; and
11 (2) painted a cream color.
12 (c) The lettering imprinted on a license plate issued under this
13 chapter shall:
14 (1) be painted in red;
15 (2) contain:

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1 (A) the registration number assigned to the registration
2 certificate by the bureau; and

3 (B) the words "Historic Motor Vehicle, State of
4 Indiana"; and

5 (3) indicate the year for which the antique motor vehicle has
6 been registered **or the year in which the antique motor**
7 **vehicle was manufactured if the vehicle is at least**
8 **twenty-five years old.**

9 (d) Instead of issuing a new license plate each time that an antique
10 motor vehicle is registered, the bureau may issue to the person who
11 owns the antique motor vehicle a tag or sticker that indicates the year
12 for which the motor vehicle has been registered.

13 (e) A license plate issued under this chapter shall be securely
14 attached to the rear of an antique motor vehicle.

15 SECTION 3. IC 9-18-15-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
16 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 1. (a) A person who is

 3 plates);

 5 (I) IC 9-18-25 (special group recognition license
 6 plates);
 7 (J) IC 9-18-29 (environmental license plates);
 8 (K) IC 9-18-30 (children's trust license plates);
 9 (L) IC 9-18-31 (education license plates);
 10 (M) IC 9-18-32 (drug free Indiana trust license
 11 plates);
 12 (N) IC 9-18-33 (Indiana FFA trust license plates);
 13 (O) IC 9-18-34 (Indiana firefighter license plates);
 14 (P) IC 9-18-35 (Indiana food bank trust license
 15 plates);
 16 (Q) IC 9-18-36 (Indiana girl scouts trust license
 17 plates);
 18 (R) IC 9-18-37 (Indiana boy scouts trust license
 19 plates); or
 20 (S) IC 9-18-38 (Indiana antique car museum trust
 21 license plates);
 22 (S) IC 9-18-38 (D.A.R.E. Indiana trust license
 23 plates);
 24 (S) IC 9-18-38 (Indiana state parks license plate);

25 **may apply to the bureau for a personalized license plate to be**
 26 **affixed to the vehicle for which registration is sought instead of the**
 27 **regular special recognition license plate.**

28 SECTION 4. IC 9-18-15-10 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 29 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 10. (a) In addition to
 30 the applicable excise tax imposed under IC 6-6-5, ~~and~~ the regular
 31 registration fees, **and any additional fee required to receive a special**
 32 **recognition license plate described in section 1(b) of this chapter,**
 33 a person applying for a personalized license plate shall pay a
 34 personalized license plate fee and contribution upon an original
 35 application.

36 (b) Each license branch shall collect the personalized license plate
 37 fee and contribution at the time of application for the personalized
 38 license plate.

39 (c) Upon the payment of the required fee and service charges for
 40 an original application or renewal of a personalized license plate, the
 41 bureau shall issue a receipt designating and acknowledging a state fee,
 42 a political contribution, and the service charge under IC 9-29.

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1 (d) The payment of regular registration fees and excise tax, if
 2 applicable, may be deferred until the time that the personalized license
 3 plate is delivered to the person who applied for the plate.

4 (e) A license branch shall collect the service charge prescribed
 5 under IC 9-29 for each initial or renewal application for a personalized
 6 license plate as a reservation and special processing fee.

7 SECTION 5. IC 9-18-26-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 8 FOLLOWS: Sec. 2. (a) The bureau shall issue dealer license plates
 9 under this chapter according to the following classifications:

10 (1) Dealer-new.

11 (2) Dealer-used.

12 (3) Manufacturer.

13 (b) The bureau may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to establish
 14 additional classifications of dealer license plates and may prescribe the
 15 general conditions for usage of an additional classification. **The**
 16 **bureau shall establish the classification of antique car museum**
 17 **dealer license plates.**

18 SECTION 6. IC 9-18-32 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 19 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 20 JULY 1, 1998]:

21 **Chapter 32. Drug Free Indiana Trust License Plates**

22 **Sec. 1. The bureau of motor vehicles shall design and issue a**
 23 **drug free Indiana trust license plate. The drug free Indiana trust**
 24 **license plate shall be designed and issued as a special group**
 25 **recognition license plate under IC 9-18-25.**

26 **Sec. 2. A drug free Indiana trust license plate designed under**
 27 **IC 9-18-25 must include the following:**

28 (1) A basic design for the plate, with consecutive numbers
 29 or letters, or both, to properly identify the vehicle.

30 (2) A background design, an emblem, or colors that
 31 designate the license plate as a drug free Indiana trust
 32 license plate.

33 (3) Any other information the bureau considers
 34 necessary.

35 **Sec. 3. After December 31, 1998, a person who is eligible to**
 36 **register a vehicle under this title is eligible to receive a drug free**
 37 **Indiana trust license plate under this chapter upon doing the**
 38 **following:**

39 (1) Completing an application for a drug free Indiana
 40 trust license plate.

41 (2) Paying the fees under section 4 of this chapter.

42 **Sec. 4. (a) The fees for a drug free Indiana trust license plate**

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1 are as follows:

2 (1) The appropriate fee under IC 9-29-5-38(a).

3 (2) An annual fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25).

4 (b) The annual fee referred to in subsection (a)(2) must be
5 collected by the bureau.

6 Sec. 5. (a) The annual fee described in section 4(a)(2) of this
7 chapter shall be deposited with the treasurer of state in a special
8 account.

9 (b) The auditor of state shall monthly distribute the money in
10 the special account established under subsection (a) to the Indiana
11 communities for Drug-Free Youth, Inc., or its successor
12 organization, if the Indiana Communities for Drug-Free Youth,
13 Inc., or its successor organization meets the following
14 requirements:

15 (1) The organization is an Indiana nonprofit corporation.

16 (2) The organization is exempt from federal income
17 taxation under Internal Revenue Code 501(c)(3).

18 However, if an organization does not meet these requirements, the
19 treasurer of state shall create a segregated account within the
20 addiction services fund established under IC 12-23-2-2, and the
21 auditor of state shall deposit the money in the account to be
22 distributed to the division of mental health.

23 (c) An organization that receives money under subsection (b)
24 shall distribute the money to local nonprofit organizations at least
25 semiannually for drug abuse education and prevention initiatives.
26 At least seventy-five percent (75%) of the amount collected from
27 each county must be distributed among one (1) or more local
28 nonprofit organizations that serve that county.

29 (d) The bureau shall provide an organization that receives
30 money under this section with a monthly report that lists by county
31 the amount of annual fees collected and deposited with the
32 treasurer of state under this chapter.

27 funds are invested. Interest that accrues from these investments

28 shall be deposited in the Indiana FFA trust fund.

29 (c) The commissioner shall administer the Indiana FFA trust

30 fund. Expenses of administering the Indiana FFA trust fund shall

31 be paid from money in the Indiana FFA trust fund.

32 (d) On June 30 of each year, the commissioner shall distribute

33 the money from the fund to the FFA Foundation that is located

34 within Indiana.

35 SECTION 8. IC 9-18-34 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE

36 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE

37 JULY 1, 1998]:

38 **Chapter 34. Indiana Firefighter License Plates**

39 **Sec. 1.** As used in this chapter, "Indiana firefighter" means a

40 person:

- 41 (1) who is:
- 42 (A) a full-time, salaried firefighter; or

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1 (B) a volunteer firefighter (as defined in
2 IC 36-8-12-2).

3 Sec. 2. (a) The bureau shall issue an Indiana firefighter license
4 plate. The Indiana firefighter license plate shall be designed and
5 issued as a special group recognition license plate under
6 IC 9-18-25.

7 (b) The bureau shall confer with representatives of the
8 Professional Firefighters Union of Indiana and the Indiana
9 Firefighters Association concerning a design for the license plate
10 as prescribed under IC 9-18-25-5.

11 Sec. 3. An Indiana firefighter license plate designed under
12 IC 9-18-25 must include the following:

13 (1) A basic design for the plate, with consecutive numbers
14 or letters, or both, to properly identify the vehicle.

15 (2) A background design, an emblem, or colors that
16 designate the license plate as an Indiana firefighter
17 license plate.

18 (3) Other information the bureau considers necessary.

19 Sec. 4. A person who is an Indiana firefighter and who is
20 eligible to register a vehicle under this title is eligible to receive at
21 least one (1) Indiana firefighter license plate upon doing the
22 following:

23 (1) Completing an application for an Indiana firefighter
24 license plate.

25 (2) Paying the appropriate fee under section 5 of this
26 chapter.

27 Sec. 5. The fee for an Indiana firefighter license plate is the
28 appropriate fee under IC 9-29-5-38.

29 SECTION 9. IC 9-18-35 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
30 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
31 JULY 1, 1998]:

32 **Chapter 35. Indiana Food Bank Trust License Plates**

33 Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "Indiana food bank" means an
34 organization that:

35 (1) is a charitable organization under Section 501(c) of the
36 Internal Revenue Code;

37 (2) is registered to do business in Indiana;

38 (3) is located within Indiana;

39 (4) is a member of a national network of food banks;

40 (5) collects and temporarily stores donated food; and

41 (6) distributes donated food only to organizations that:

42 (A) are charitable organizations under Section 501(c)

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1 of the Internal Revenue Code; and

2 (B) distribute donated food to people in Indiana.

3 **Sec. 2.** The bureau shall design and issue an Indiana food bank
4 trust license plate. The Indiana food bank trust license plate must
5 be designed and issued as a special group recognition license plate
6 under IC 9-18-25.

7 **Sec. 3.** An Indiana food bank trust license plate designed under
8 IC 9-18-25 must include the following:

9 (1) A basic design for the plate, with consecutive numbers
10 or letters, or both, to properly identify the vehicle.

11 (2) A background design, an emblem, or colors that
12 designate the license plate as an Indiana food bank trust
13 license plate.

14 (3) Other information the bureau considers necessary.

15 **Sec. 4.** After December 31, 1998, a person who is eligible to
16 register a vehicle under this title is eligible to receive an Indiana
17 food bank trust license plate under this chapter upon doing the
18 following:

19 (1) Completing an application for an Indiana food bank
20 trust license plate.

36 **Sec. 6.** (a) The Indiana food bank trust fund is established.

37 (b) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the Indiana
38 food bank trust fund not currently needed to meet the obligations
39 of the Indiana food bank trust fund in the same manner as other
40 public trust funds are invested. Interest that accrues from these
41 investments shall be deposited in the Indiana food bank trust fund.

42 (c) The bureau shall administer the Indiana food bank trust



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1 fund. Expenses of administering the Indiana food bank trust fund
2 shall be paid from money in the Indiana food bank trust fund.

3 (d) Subject to subsection (e), on June 30 of each year, the
4 bureau shall distribute money in the fund attributable to a
5 recipient of an Indiana food bank trust license plate:

6 (1) to the Indiana food bank that serves the county in
7 which the vehicle is registered; or

8 (2) if there is not a food bank serving the county in which
9 the vehicle is registered, to each Indiana food bank in
10 proportion to the number of impoverished people served
11 by the Indiana food bank.

12 (e) On June 30 of each year, the commissioner shall distribute
13 money attributable to a donation received under section 5(d) of this
14 chapter to the Indiana food bank designated by the donor. If a
15 donor does not provide instructions regarding distribution, money
16 from a donor and interest attributable to the money from the
17 donor shall be distributed:

18 (1) to the Indiana food bank that serves the county where
19 the donor's residence is located; or

20 (2) if there is not a food bank serving the donor's county
21 of residence, to each Indiana food bank in proportion to
22 the number of impoverished people served by the Indiana
23 food bank.

24 SECTION 10. IC 9-18-36 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
25 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
26 JULY 1, 1998]:

36 (2) A background design, an emblem, or colors that
37 designate the license plate as an Indiana girl scouts trust
38 license plate.

39 (3) Any other information the bureau considers
40 necessary.

41 **Sec. 3.** After December 31, 1998, a person who is eligible to
42 register a vehicle under this title is eligible to receive an Indiana

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1 girl scouts trust license plate under this chapter upon doing the

20 currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same
21 manner as other public trust funds are invested. Interest that
22 accrues from these investments shall be deposited in the fund.

23 (c) The commissioner shall administer the fund. Expenses of
24 administering the fund shall be paid from money in the fund.

25 (d) Subject to subsection (e), on June 30 of each year the
26 commissioner shall distribute from the fund to each council of the
27 Girl Scouts of America that is located entirely or partially within
28 Indiana that part of the fund that is attributable to vehicles that
29 are registered with an Indiana girl scouts license plate within the
30 same geographic area as the council.

31 (e) On June 30 of each year the commissioner shall distribute
32 from the fund money attributable to a donation received under
33 section 4(d) of this chapter to the council of the Girl Scouts of
34 America designated by the donor. If the donor does not provide
35 instructions regarding distribution, money from a donor and
36 interest attributable to the money from the donor shall be
37 distributed to the council of the Girl Scouts of America that is
38 located in the geographic area where the donor's residence is
39 located.

40 SECTION 11. IC 9-18-37 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE

If the donor did not provide instructions regarding distribution, money from a donor and interest attributable to the money from the donor shall be distributed to the county where the donor's residence is located.

(1) to the Indiana food bank that serves the county in which the vehicle is registered; or

(2) if there is not a food bank serving the county in which the vehicle is registered, to each Indiana food bank in proportion to the number of impoverished people served by the Indiana food bank.
