DIGEST OF HB1206 (Updated January 27, 1998 12:53 pm - DI 93)

Citations Affected: IC 9-19-10-3.

Synopsis: Passenger restraint systems. Provides that a vehicle may be stopped to determine compliance with the law concerning passenger restraint systems. Specifies that a vehicle, the contents of a vehicle, the driver of a vehicle, or a passenger in a vehicle may not be inspected, searched, or detained solely because of a violation of the law concerning passenger restraint systems.

Effective: July 1, 1998.

Additions: Whenever a new statutory provision is being enacted (or a new constitutional provision adopted), the text of the new provision will appear in **this style type**. Also, the word **NEW** will appear in that style type in the introductory clause of each SECTION that adds a new provision to the Indiana Code or the Indiana Constitution.

Conflict reconciliation: Text in a statute in *this style type* or ~~this style type~~ reconciles conflicts between statutes enacted by the 1997 General Assembly.

HOUSE BILL No. 1206

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-19-10-3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 3. **A vehicle may be**
3 **stopped to determine compliance with this chapter. However, a**
4 **person vehicle, the contents of a vehicle, the driver of a vehicle, or**
5 **a passenger in a vehicle** may not be ~~stopped~~, inspected, searched, or
6 detained solely to ~~determine compliance with~~ **because of a violation**
7 **of this chapter.**
