DIGEST OF HB 1299 (Updated January 28, 1998 1:46 pm - DI 73)

**Citations Affected:** Noncode.

**Synopsis:** Requires the department of correction to develop a plan concerning protection and appropriate programs for persons who are less than 18 years of age and who were committed as adults to the department of correction. Requires the department of correction to submit the plan to the state budget committee before September 30, 1998, in connection with the department's budget request.

PRINTING CODE. Amendments: Whenever an existing statute (or a section of the Indiana Constitution) is being amended, the text of the existing provision will appear in this style type, additions will appear in **this style type**, and deletions will appear in ~~this style type~~.

Additions: Whenever a new statutory provision is being enacted (or a new constitutional provision adopted), the text of the new provision will appear in **this style type**. Also, the word **NEW** will appear in that style type in the introductory clause of each SECTION that adds a new provision to the Indiana Code or the Indiana Constitution.

Conflict reconciliation: Text in a statute in *this style type* or ~~this style type~~ reconciles conflicts between statutes enacted by the 1997 General Assembly.

## HOUSE BILL No. 1299

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning corrections.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1       SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **The department**  
2 **of correction shall develop a plan concerning protection and**  
3 **appropriate programs for persons who are less than eighteen (18)**  
4 **years of age and who were committed as adults to the department**  
5 **of correction.**  
6       (b) **The department of correction shall submit the plan**  
7 **developed under subsection (a) to the state budget committee**  
8 **before September 30, 1998. The department of correction shall**  
9 **submit the plan in connection with the department's budget**  
10 **request submitted to the state budget committee for fiscal years**  
11 **1999 - 2001.**  
12       (c) **This SECTION expires July 1, 2001.**  
13       SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
