Synopsis: Guaranteed energy savings contracts. Provides that for Indianapolis, the board that awards contracts for public work is the body that may enter into a guaranteed energy savings contract.

PRINTING CODE. Amendments: Whenever an existing statute (or a section of the Indiana Constitution) is being amended, the text of the existing provision will appear in this style type, additions will appear in **this style type**, and deletions will appear in ~~this style type~~.

Additions: Whenever a new statutory provision is being enacted (or a new constitutional provision adopted), the text of the new provision will appear in **this style type**. Also, the word **NEW** will appear in that style type in the introductory clause of each SECTION that adds a new provision to the Indiana Code or the Indiana Constitution.

Conflict reconciliation: Text in a statute in *this style type* or ~~this style type~~ reconciles conflicts between statutes enacted by the 1997 General Assembly.

HOUSE BILL No. 1312

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 36-1-12.5-1.5, AS ADDED BY P.L.208-1995,
2 SECTION 4, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 1.5. As used in this chapter, "governing body"
4 means:
5 (1) with respect to school corporations, the governing body (as
6 defined in IC 20-10.1-1-5); ~~and~~
7 (2) with respect to other political subdivisions, **except a**
8 **consolidated city**, the legislative body (as defined in
9 IC 36-1-2-9); **and**
10 (3) **with respect to a consolidated city, the board (as defined**
11 **in IC 36-1-12-1.2).**
