



**CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT  
DIGEST FOR SB 248**

**Citations Affected:** IC 7.1-3-22-10.

**Synopsis:** Sale and retirement of excess ABC permits. Conference committee report for ESB 248. Provides that a city or town may purchase an alcoholic beverage commission permit that is subject to a quota and that legally exceeds the quota (because of "grandfathering") at a price agreed to by the executive and the permit holder and approved by the legislative body. Requires a city or town that purchases a permit that exists outside the quota to return the permit to the alcoholic beverage commission. Requires the commission to retire the permit. (This conference committee removes all SECTIONS from the bill except for SECTION 11. Removes SECTIONS from the bill concerning the penalty for furnishing alcoholic beverage to minors, transport of beer or wine manufactured in a person's residence, furnishing of illuminated signs, defenses to furnishing alcoholic beverage to a minor, sampling of liquors, beer wholesalers permits in certain counties, and the method of measuring distance between a proposed premises and a church or school.)
