MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Public Health, to which was referred Senate Bill 261, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Delete the amendment made on motion of Senator Miller adopted
- 2 February 2, 1998.
- 3 Delete the title and insert the following:
- 4 A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning
- 5 health and to make an appropriation.
- 6 Page 3, line 7, after "physician" insert "**who:**
- 7 **(1) believes that testing a newborn for the human**
- 8 **immunodeficiency virus (HIV) or the antibody or antigen to**
- 9 **HIV is medically necessary; and**
- 10 **(2) notifies at least one (1) of the newborn's parents of the**
- 11 **test;**".
- 12 Page 3, line 7, beginning with "may" begin a new line blocked left.
- 13 Page 3, line 7, delete "an" and insert "**a test**".
- 14 Page 3, line 8, delete "examination".
- 15 Page 3, line 10, after "." insert "**A test may be ordered under this**
- 16 **subsection if funds provided under Section 2625 of the Ryan White**

1 **CARE Amendments of 1996 (42 U.S.C. 300ff-21 et seq.) are**
 2 **available to pay for the test."**

3 Page 3, line 34, delete "." and insert ", **including requiring**
 4 **hospitals and physicians to provide education to the families of**
 5 **newborns about the risk of transferring HIV through**
 6 **breastfeeding if the mother is or may be infected with HIV or has**
 7 **the antibody or antigen to HIV."**

8 Page 3, after line 36, begin a new paragraph and insert:

9 "SECTION 6. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] **The state**
 10 **department of health shall apply for funds under Section 2625 of**
 11 **the Ryan White CARE Amendments of 1996 (42 U.S.C. 300ff-21 et**
 12 **seq.) to pay for all tests conducted under IC 16-41-17-2(b), as**
 13 **amended by this act.**

14 SECTION 7. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998] (a) **There is**
 15 **appropriated to the state department of health forty-nine thousand**
 16 **nine hundred and ninety-nine dollars (\$49,999) from the state**
 17 **general fund to pay for tests conducted under IC 16-41-17-2(b), as**
 18 **amended by this act, beginning July 1, 1998, and ending June 30,**
 19 **1999.**

20 **(b) This SECTION expires July 1, 1999.**

21 SECTION 8. **An emergency is declared for this act."**

22 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.

(Reference is to SB 261 as printed January 30, 1998, and as amended on motion of Senator Miller adopted February 2, 1998.)
