MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Environmental Affairs, to which was referred Senate Bill 387, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
- 2 paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 1. IC 13-21-3-5, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-1996,
- 4 SECTION 11, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 5 JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 5. (a) Except as provided in subsections (b)
- 6 through (d), the board of a county district consists of the following
- 7 members:
- 8 (1) Two (2) members appointed by the county executive from
- 9 the membership of the county executive.
- 10 (2) One (1) member appointed by the county fiscal body from
- 11 the membership of the fiscal body.
- 12 (3) One (1) member:
- 13 (A) who is the executive of the municipality having the
- 14 largest population in the county if that municipality is a city;
- 15 or
- 16 (B) appointed from the membership of the legislative body

1 of a town if the town is the municipality having the largest
2 population in the county.

3 (4) One (1) member of the legislative body of the municipality
4 with the largest population in the county appointed by the
5 legislative body of that municipality.

6 (5) One (1) member:

7 (A) who is the executive of a city in the county that is not
8 the municipality having the largest population in the county;
9 or

10 (B) who is a member of the legislative body of a town that
11 is not the municipality having the largest population in the
12 county;

13 and who is appointed by the executive of that county to represent
14 the municipalities in the county other than the municipality
15 having the largest population.

16 (6) One (1) additional member appointed by the county
17 executive from the membership of the county executive.

18 (b) If a county having a population of more than four hundred
19 thousand (400,000) but less than seven hundred thousand (700,000) is
20 designated as a county district, the executives of the three (3) cities in
21 the county having the largest populations each serve as a member of
22 the board **or may appoint a member of the legislative body of their**
23 **city to serve as a member of the board.** If a county having a
24 population of more than two hundred thousand (200,000) but less than
25 three hundred thousand (300,000) is designated as a county district, the
26 executives of the two (2) cities in the county having the largest
27 populations each serve as a member of the board. If a county having a
28 population of more than two hundred thousand (200,000) but less than
29 three hundred thousand (300,000) is designated as a county district, the
30 board of that county district must include the following:

31 (1) One (1) member of the legislative body of the city having the
32 second largest population in the county, appointed by the
33 president of the city legislative body.

34 (2) One (1) member of the legislative body of a town located in
35 the county, appointed by the judge of the circuit court in the
36 county.

37 (c) If a county having a consolidated city is designated a county
38 district, the board of public works established under IC 36-3-5-6

1 constitutes the board of the county district.

2 (d) If a county designated as a county district has a population of
3 more than four hundred thousand (400,000) but less than seven
4 hundred thousand (700,000), the board of the district consists of the
5 following members:

6 (1) One (1) member appointed by the county executive from the
7 membership of the county executive.

8 (2) Two (2) members appointed from the county fiscal body
9 appointed from the membership of the county fiscal body.

10 (3) The executive of each second or third class city **or a**
11 **member of the legislative body of their city appointed by the**
12 **executive.**

13 (4) One (1) member of the legislative body of each town
14 appointed by the legislative body.

15 (5) One (1) member of the legislative body of the municipality
16 with the largest population in the county appointed by the
17 legislative body of that municipality.

18 (6) If a local government unit in the county has an operating final
19 disposal facility located within the unit's jurisdiction, one (1)
20 member of the unit's board of public works appointed by the
21 board of public works."

22 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
