Whereas, The Ten Commandments are a declaration of fundamental principles that are the cornerstone of a fair and just society: Therefore,

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, the Senate concurring:

3 government offices and courthouses, should be permitted.
