

SENATE BILL No. 9

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: None (noncode).

Synopsis: National women veterans' memorial. Appropriates from the state general fund \$22,000 for the Women's Memorial Ceremonial Gateway to Arlington National Cemetery. Requires the treasurer of state to transfer the amount appropriated to the appropriate national fund for the Women's Memorial.

Effective: Upon passage.

SENATE BILL No. 9

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning state police, civil defense and military affairs and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **There is**
2 **appropriated from the state general fund to the Women's Memorial**
3 **Ceremonial Gateway to Arlington National Cemetery (the Women's**
4 **Memorial) twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000) to honor women**
5 **who served in the military.**
6 (b) **The treasurer of state shall transfer the amount appropriated**
7 **under this SECTION to the appropriate national fund for the**
8 **Women's Memorial.**
9 (c) **This SECTION expires July 1, 1999.**
10 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
