A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-18-32 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS  
2 A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
3 JANUARY 1, 1999]:

4 **Chapter 32. Indiana Vietnam Veteran License Plates**  
5 **Sec. 1. The bureau shall design and issue a passenger vehicle**  
6 **license plate that will designate the vehicle as being registered to a**  
7 **person who is a Vietnam veteran.**

8 **Sec. 2. A resident of Indiana who is a Vietnam veteran may apply**  
9 **for and receive one (1) or more Vietnam veteran license plates.**

10 **Sec. 3. A Vietnam veteran license plate may be displayed only on**  
11 **a vehicle registered by a person described in section 2 of this**  
12 **chapter.**

13 **Sec. 4. The bureau may not register a passenger car or truck**  
14 **under this chapter if the passenger car or truck has a declared gross**  
15 **weight of more than eleven thousand (11,000) pounds.**
