DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: None (noncode).

Synopsis: Reestablish managed care study committee. Reestablishes the managed care study committee for two years. Requires the committee to study all aspects of managed care, with particular attention paid to data collection and grievance procedures.

Effective: Upon passage.

SENATE BILL No. 14

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning insurance.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **As used in this**
2 **SECTION, "committee" refers to the managed care study**
3 **committee:**
4 (1) **originally established in P.L.251-1996; and**
5 (2) **reestablished by subsection (b).**
6 (b) **The managed care study committee is reestablished.**
7 (c) **The committee shall study all aspects of managed care,**
8 **including:**
9 (1) **data collection; and**
10 (2) **grievance procedures.**
11 (d) **The committee is under the jurisdiction of the legislative**
12 **council and shall operate under policies and procedures established**
13 **by the legislative council.**
14 (e) **Before November 1, 1998, the committee shall issue a**
15 **preliminary report that:**
16 (1) **describes the actions taken by the committee during 1998;**
17 **and**
18 (2) **presents any preliminary conclusions reached and any**

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- 1 preliminary findings and recommendations made by the
2 committee during 1998.
- 3 (f) The committee shall issue a final report stating its findings,
4 conclusions, and recommendations before November 1, 1999.
- 5 (g) The committee shall issue other reports as directed by the
6 legislative council.
- 7 (h) The committee consists of twelve (12) members of the
8 general assembly as follows:
- 9 (1) The president pro tempore of the senate shall appoint six
10 (6) senators, not more than three (3) of whom are of the same
11 political party, as members of the committee.
- 12 (2) The speaker of the house of representatives shall appoint
13 six (6) representatives, not more than three (3) of whom are
14 of the same political party, as members of the committee.
- 15 (i) The chairman of the legislative council shall name one (1) of
16 the members as chairman. The vice chairman of the legislative
17 council shall name one (1) of the members as vice chairman.
- 18 (j) A member of the committee serves at the pleasure of the
19 appointing authority who appointed the member.
- 20 (k) The committee shall meet during the interim between
21 adjournment of the 1998 regular session of the general assembly
22 and November 1, 1999, on the call of the chairman or at other
23 times the committee determines.
- 24 (l) Notice of the time, place, and agenda of committee meetings
25 shall be given in the same manner as meetings of interim study
26 committees established by the legislative council.
- 27 (m) Each member of the committee is entitled to receive the
28 same per diem, mileage, and travel allowances paid to members of
29 the general assembly serving on interim study committees
30 established by the legislative council.
- 31 (n) Staff and administrative support for the committee shall be
32 provided by the legislative services agency.
- 33 (o) The legislative council may establish a budget for the
34 committee.
- 35 (p) Subject to prior authorization of the legislative council, the
36 expenses incurred by the committee in performing the duties of the
37 committee shall be paid from the funds appropriated to the
38 legislative council.
- 39 (q) This SECTION expires December 31, 1999.
- 40 SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
