### DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 2-3-1-1.

**Synopsis:** Legislator salaries. Beginning January 1, 1999, provides that the annual salary of a member of the general assembly is \$28,000. Provides that certain officers of the senate and the house of representatives are entitled to receive a specified compensation in addition to the annual base salary. (The amounts of the additional compensation are currently contained in the 1997 budget act.)

**Effective:** January 1, 1999.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning the general assembly.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 2-3-1-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
2 [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1999]: Sec. 1. (a) The annual salary of the  
3 members of the general assembly ~~shall be eleven~~ **is twenty-eight**  
4 thousand ~~six hundred~~ dollars (~~\$11,600~~). **(\$28,000)**. One-half (1/2) the  
5 annual salary shall be paid on the fifteenth day of January, and one-half  
6 (1/2) the annual salary shall be paid on the fifteenth day of February.
