DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 10-2-2-9.5.

Synopsis: State armory board funds. Allows the state armory board to contribute funds to finance the statutory duties of the adjutant-general.

Effective: Upon passage.

SENATE BILL No. 68

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning military affairs.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 10-2-2-9.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON
3 PASSAGE]: **Sec. 9.5. The state armory board may contribute funds**
4 **in support of any of the statutory duties and responsibilities of the**
5 **adjutant-general.**

6 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
