

# SENATE BILL No. 131

---

## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 9-18-32; IC 9-18-33.

**Synopsis:** License plates. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles to design and issue an Indiana girl scouts trust license plate and an Indiana boy scouts trust license plate. Establishes the Indiana girl scouts trust fund and the Indiana boy scouts trust fund. Establishes an additional \$25 fee for the license plate that must be deposited in the Indiana girl scouts trust fund or the Indiana boy scouts trust fund. Provides that the commissioner of the bureau of motor vehicles administers the fund. Provides that on June 30 of each year, the commissioner of the bureau of motor vehicles shall distribute to each council of the girl scouts and the boy scouts located in Indiana that part of each respective fund that is attributable to vehicles registered for the

special license plate in the same geographic area as the council. Provides that the commissioner of the bureau of motor vehicles may accept gifts to the Indiana girl scouts trust fund or the Indiana boy scouts trust fund to be distributed to the council of the Girl Scouts of America or the council of the Boy Scouts of America as designated by the donor.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-18-32 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS  
2 A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
3 1, 1998]:

4 **Chapter 32. Indiana Girl Scouts Trust License Plates**  
5 **Sec. 1. The bureau of motor vehicles shall design and issue an**  
6 **Indiana girl scouts trust license plate. The Indiana girl scouts trust**  
7 **license plate shall be designed and issued as a special group**  
8 **recognition license plate under IC 9-18-25.**

9 **Sec. 2. An Indiana girl scouts trust license plate designed under**  
10 **IC 9-18-25 must include the following:**

- 11 (1) A basic design for the plate, with consecutive numbers or  
12 letters, or both, to properly identify the vehicle.  
13 (2) A background design, an emblem, or colors that designate  
14 the license plate as an Indiana girl scouts trust license plate.  
15 (3) Any other information the bureau considers necessary.



1           **Sec. 3. After December 31, 1998, a person who is eligible to**  
 2 **register a vehicle under this title is eligible to receive an Indiana**  
 3 **girl scouts trust license plate under this chapter upon doing the**  
 4 **following:**

8           **Sec. 4. (a) The fees for an Indiana girl scouts trust license plate**

11           **(2) An annual fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25).**

12           **(b) The annual fee referred to in subsection (a)(2) must be**  
 13 **collected by the bureau.**

14           **(c) The bureau shall deposit the annual fee described in**  
 15 **subsection (a)(2) and the donations described in subsection (d) in**  
 16 **the fund established by section 5 of this chapter.**

17           **(d) Subject to IC 5-14-3-4(b)(15), the commissioner may receive**  
 18 **donations for deposit in the fund established by section 5 of this**  
 19 **chapter.**

20           **Sec. 5. (a) The Indiana girl scouts trust fund is established.**

21           **(b) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the Indiana**  
 22 **girl scouts trust fund not currently needed to meet the obligations**  
 23 **of the Indiana girl scouts trust fund in the same manner as other**  
 24 **public trust funds are invested. Interest that accrues from these**  
 25 **investments shall be deposited in the Indiana girl scouts trust fund.**

26           **(c) The commissioner shall administer the Indiana girl scouts**  
 27 **trust fund. Expenses of administering the Indiana girl scouts trust**  
 28 **fund shall be paid from money in the Indiana girl scouts trust fund.**

29           **(d) Subject to subsection (e), on June 30 of each year, the**  
 30 **commissioner shall distribute to each council of the Girl Scouts of**  
 31 **America that is located entirely or partially within Indiana that**  
 32 **part of the fund that is attributable to vehicles registered for the**  
 33 **Indiana girl scouts trust license plate within the same geographic**  
 34 **area as the council.**

35           **(e) On June 30 of each year, the commissioner shall distribute**  
 36 **money attributable to a donation received under section 4(d) of this**  
 37 **chapter according to the council of the Girl Scouts of America**  
 38 **designated by the donor. If the donor did not provide instructions**  
 39 **regarding distribution, money from a donor and interest**  
 40 **attributable to the money from the donor shall be distributed to the**  
 41 **council of the Girl Scouts of America that is located in the**  
 42 **geographic area where the donor's residence is located.**



1 SECTION 2. IC 9-18-33 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS  
 2 A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
 3 1, 1998]:

4 **Chapter 33. Indiana Boy Scouts Trust License Plates**

5 **Sec. 1. The bureau of motor vehicles shall design and issue an**  
 6 **Indiana boy scouts trust license plate. The Indiana boy scouts trust**  
 7 **license plate shall be designed and issued as a special group**  
 8 **recognition license plate under IC 9-18-25.**

9 **Sec. 2. An Indiana boy scouts trust license plate designed under**  
 10 **IC 9-18-25 must include the following:**

11 (1) A basic design for the plate, with consecutive numbers or  
 12 letters, or both, to properly identify the vehicle.

13 (2) A background design, an emblem, or colors that designate  
 14 the license plate as an Indiana boy scouts trust license plate.

15 (3) Any other information the bureau considers necessary.

16 **Sec. 3. After December 31, 1998, a person who is eligible to**

32 (d) Subject to IC 5-14-3-4(b)(15), the commissioner may receive  
 33 donations for deposit in the fund established by section 5 of this  
 34 chapter.

35 **Sec. 5. (a) The Indiana boy scouts trust fund is established.**

36 (b) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the Indiana  
 37 boy scouts trust fund not currently needed to meet the obligations  
 38 of the Indiana boy scouts trust fund in the same manner as other  
 39 public trust funds are invested. Interest that accrues from these  
 40 investments shall be deposited in the Indiana boy scouts trust fund.

41 (c) The commissioner shall administer the Indiana boy scouts  
 42 trust fund. Expenses of administering the Indiana boy scouts trust

8 (e) On June 30 of each year, the commissioner shall distribute  
9 money attributable to a donation received under section 4(d) of this  
10 chapter according to the council of the Boy Scouts of America  
11 designated by the donor. If the donor did not provide instructions  
12 regarding distribution, money from a donor and interest  
13 attributable to the money from the donor shall be distributed to the  
14 council of the Boy Scouts of America that is located in the  
15 geographic area where the donor's residence is located.
