

SENATE BILL No. 156

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 25-8.

Synopsis: Cosmetology continuing education. Repeals the continuing education requirement for cosmetology professionals. Voids the state board of cosmetology examiners' continuing education administrative rule.

Effective: July 1, 1998.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning professions and occupations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

9 SECTION 2. IC 25-8-4-21, AS AMENDED BY P.L.239-1995,
10 SECTION 5, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
11 JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 21. Except as provided in IC 25-8-9-11, the board
12 may, upon application, restore a license under this chapter that has
13 expired if the person holding the license **does all of the following:**
14 (1) Pays any unpaid renewal fees to the board.
15 (2) Pays the license restoration fee set forth in IC 25-8-13.
16 (3) Complies with all requirements imposed by this article on an
17 applicant for an initial license to perform the acts authorized by

 8 JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 2. An individual with an inactive license:

9 (1) may not perform an act that requires a cosmetology
 10 professional license listed under IC 25-8-2-5.5; **and**

15 SECTION 4. IC 25-8-16-3, AS ADDED BY P.L.239-1995,
 16 SECTION 8, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 17 JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 3. If an inactive cosmetology professional intends

18 to apply for restoration of the professional's license, the cosmetology
 19 professional shall notify the board of that intent. The board may restore
 20 the cosmetology professional's license upon notification and receipt of

21 ~~(1) an application. and~~

22 ~~(2) evidence of completion during the preceding four (4) years of~~
 23 ~~at least sixteen (16) hours of continuing education in a continuing~~
 24 ~~education course approved by the board under IC 25-8-15.~~

25 SECTION 5. THE FOLLOWING ARE REPEALED [EFFECTIVE
 26 JULY 1, 1998]: IC 25-8-2-2.5; IC 25-8-2-3.5; IC 25-8-15.

27 SECTION 6. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998] **(a) 820 IAC 6 is void.**

28 **(b) The publisher of the Indiana Administrative Code and the**
 29 **Indiana Register shall remove 820 IAC 6 from the Indiana**
 30 **Administrative Code.**
