DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Synopsis: Appropriation to the Scott County YMCA. Appropriates \$500,000 from the build Indiana fund to the Scott County YMCA for the construction of a new building.

SENATE BILL No. 186

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning capital projects and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998] (a) **There is**
2 **appropriated to the Scott County YMCA five hundred thousand**
3 **dollars (\$500,000), from the state and local capital projects account**
4 **of the build Indiana fund under IC 4-30-17, for the construction of**
5 **a new building for the state fiscal year beginning July 1, 1998, and**
6 **ending June 30, 1999.**
7 (b) **This SECTION expires July 1, 1999.**
