

SENATE BILL No. 206

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-21-8-48.

Synopsis: Covering loads likely to spill on the highway. Requires a truck hauling material that is likely to fall, sift, blow, drop, or otherwise escape from the vehicle to have the load covered.

Effective: July 1, 1998.

SENATE BILL No. 206

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 9-21-8-48 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 48. (a) A vehicle,
3 except:
4 (1) a vehicle containing poultry or livestock being transported to
5 market; or
6 (2) a highway maintenance vehicle engaged in spreading sand or
7 deicing chemicals;
8 may not be driven or moved on a highway if the vehicle's contents are
9 dripping, sifting, leaking, or otherwise escaping from the vehicle.
10 (b) **A vehicle transporting sand, dirt, gravel, stone, or other**
11 **material that is likely to fall, sift, blow, drop, or otherwise escape**
12 **from the vehicle may not be driven or moved on a highway unless**
13 **the load of material is covered in a manner that prevents the**
14 **material from falling, sifting, blowing, dropping, or otherwise**
15 **escaping the vehicle.**
