DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 5-10-8-6.

Synopsis: Insurance for retired state police employees. Provides that the state police department may provide a group insurance plan for retired employees in which retired employees pay a negotiated premium and in which the cost of claims and administration may be recovered through increased premiums to employees or other funding sources.

Effective: July 1, 1998.

SENATE BILL No. 270

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 5-10-8-6 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
2 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 6. (a) The state police department,
3 conservation officers of the department of natural resources, and the
4 state excise police may establish common and unified plans of
5 self-insurance for their employees, including retired employees, as
6 separate entities of state government. These plans may be administered
7 by a private agency, business firm, limited liability company, or
8 corporation.
9 (b) ~~The state agencies listed in subsection (a)~~ **conservation officers**
10 **of the department of natural resources and the state excise police**
11 may not pay as the employer portion of benefits for any employee or
12 retiree an amount greater than that paid for other state employees for
13 group insurance.
14 (c) **The state police department may provide for a group**
15 **insurance plan in which:**
16 (1) **the retired employees pay a negotiated premium that may**
17 **vary depending on the year in which the employee retired;**
