DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-18-18-6; IC 9-18-18-7.

Synopsis: Disabled veteran license plates. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles to include the words "Disabled American Veteran" on a disabled veteran license plate.

Effective: July 1, 1998.

SENATE BILL No. 340



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-18-18-6 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 6. In the design of
3 disabled veteran license plates, the bureau shall **do the following**:

4 (1) **include the words "Disabled American Veteran" on the**
5 **license plate; and**

6 (2) develop two (2) classes of license plates as follows:

7 (†) (A) Class I license plates that may only be issued to
8 persons who are certified as having a one hundred percent
9 (100%) service-connected disability.

10 (‡) (B) Class II license plates for other persons qualified for a
11 license plate under this chapter.

12 SECTION 2. IC 9-18-18-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
13 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 7. A Class I license
14 plate must be blue and gold in color and contain ~~the following~~:

15 (†) identification numerals.

16 (‡) ~~The words "Disabled Am Vet"~~.
