

SENATE BILL No. 380

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: None (noncode).

Synopsis: Residential services appropriation. Requires the division of disability, aging, and rehabilitative services to authorize and make available all of the residential services for developmentally disabled persons appropriation beginning on July 1, 1997, and ending July 1, 1999, for the appropriate placement of persons currently residing in intermediate care facilities, skilled nursing facilities, or the community.

Effective: Upon passage.

SENATE BILL No. 380

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning human services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a)
2 **Notwithstanding P.L.260-1997, the division of disability, aging, and**
3 **rehabilitative services shall authorize and make available all of the**
4 **residential services for developmentally disabled persons**
5 **appropriation, beginning on July 1, 1997, and ending July 1, 1999,**
6 **for the appropriate placement of persons currently residing in**
7 **intermediate care facilities, skilled nursing facilities, or the**
8 **community. The amounts authorized and made available by the**
9 **division of disability, aging, and rehabilitative services must be**
10 **disbursed on a units purchase of services basis.**
11 (b) **This SECTION expires July 1, 1999.**
12 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**



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
