

SENATE BILL No. 430

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 12-7-2-55.1; IC 12-15-32-4.

Synopsis: Medicaid reimbursement for day services. Provides for Medicaid reimbursement for day services in community residential facilities for the developmentally disabled.

Effective: July 1, 1998.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning human services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 12-7-2-55.1 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: **Sec. 55.1. "Day services", for**
4 **purposes of IC 12-15-32, means the following services provided to**
5 **adult individuals with developmental disabilities:**

- 6 (1) **Supported employment follow-along.**
- 7 (2) **Sheltered work and community based sheltered work.**
- 8 (3) **Individual and group habilitation.**
- 9 (4) **Individual and group occupational therapy.**
- 10 (5) **Individual and group physical therapy.**
- 11 (6) **Individual and group speech therapy.**
- 12 (7) **Transportation.**

13 SECTION 2. IC 12-15-32-4, AS AMENDED BY P.L.78-1994,
14 SECTION 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
15 JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 4. The criteria for reimbursement under this
16 chapter must include the following:



- 1 (1) The method of determining initial rates of reimbursement.
- 2 (2) The method of determining the maximum rate of
- 3 reimbursement.
- 4 (3) The frequency of rate reviews.
- 5 (4) The method of depreciating the buildings comprising the
- 6 facilities.
- 7 (5) The establishment of a maximum depreciation expense.
- 8 (6) The inclusion of first aid supplies as a part of the room charge.
- 9 (7) The establishment of maximum costs of equipment purchases
- 10 or repairs that may be allowed as depreciation expenses.
- 11 (8) The establishment of limitations on allowable interest
- 12 expenses.
- 13 (9) The establishment of a limit on the duration of financing.
- 14 **(10) The inclusion of day service expenses as reimbursable**
- 15 **ancillary expenses, in the same manner as physical, speech,**
- 16 **and occupational therapy are included in the room rate for a**
- 17 **community residential facility for the developmentally**
- 18 **disabled.**
- 19 **(11) The inclusion of day service expenses in profit ceilings,**
- 20 **profit add-on calculations, and overall rate limits for all rate**
- 21 **calculations that include day service expenses as a**
- 22 **reimbursable expense, in the same manner as physical,**
- 23 **speech, and occupational therapy are included in the room**
- 24 **rate for a community residential facility for the**
- 25 **developmentally disabled.**

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
