

SENATE BILL No. 443

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 4-32-9-16.5.

Synopsis: Charitable gaming donations. Repeals the requirement that a charitable organization that receives 90% or more of the organization's total gross receipts from charitable gaming events is required to donate 60% of its gross charitable gaming receipts less prize payout to another qualified organization.

Effective: July 1, 1998.
