

HOUSE BILL No. 1059

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-18-32; IC 9-18-33.

Synopsis: Scout license plates. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles to design and issue an Indiana girl scouts trust license plate and an Indiana boy scouts trust license plate. Establishes the Indiana girl scouts trust fund and the Indiana boy scouts trust fund. Requires an additional annual fee of \$25 to purchase a scout license plate. Provides that the additional annual fee shall be deposited in the Indiana girl scouts trust fund or the Indiana boy scouts trust fund. Provides that the commissioner of the bureau of motor vehicles administers the fund. Provides that on June 30 of each year, the commissioner of the bureau of motor vehicles shall

distribute to each council of the Girl Scouts of America and the Boy Scouts of America located in Indiana that part of their respective funds that is attributable to vehicles that are registered with specialized license plates within the same geographic area as the council. Provides that the commissioner of the bureau of motor vehicles may accept gifts to the Indiana girl scouts trust fund and the Indiana boy scouts trust fund to be distributed to the council of the Girl Scouts of America or the council of the Boy Scouts of America as designated by the donor.

HOUSE BILL No. 1059

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-18-32 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
2 A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1,
3 1998]:

4 **Chapter 32. Indiana Girl Scouts Trust License Plates**
5 **Sec. 1. The bureau of motor vehicles shall design and issue an**
6 **Indiana girl scouts trust license plate. The Indiana girl scouts trust**
7 **license plate shall be designed and issued as a special group**
8 **recognition license plate under IC 9-18-25.**

9 **Sec. 2. An Indiana girl scouts trust license plate designed under**
10 **IC 9-18-25 must include the following:**

- 11 (1) **A basic design for the plate, with consecutive numbers or**
12 **letters, or both, to properly identify the vehicle.**
13 (2) **A background design, an emblem, or colors that designate**
14 **the license plate as an Indiana girl scouts trust license plate.**
15 (3) **Any other information the bureau considers necessary.**

21 (b) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not
 22 currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same
 23 manner as other public trust funds are invested. Interest that
 24 accrues from these investments shall be deposited in the fund.

25 (c) The commissioner shall administer the fund. Expenses of
 26 administering the fund shall be paid from money in the fund.

27 (d) Subject to subsection (e), on June 30 of each year, the
 28 commissioner shall distribute from the fund to each council of the
 29 Girl Scouts of America that is located entirely or partially within
 30 Indiana that part of the fund that is attributable to vehicles that are
 31 registered with an Indiana girl scouts license plate within the same
 32 geographic area as the council.

33 (e) On June 30 of each year, the commissioner shall distribute
 34 from the fund money attributable to a donation received under
 35 section 4(d) of this chapter to the council of the Girl Scouts of
 36 America designated by the donor. If the donor does not provide
 37 instructions regarding distribution, money from a donor and interest
 38 attributable to the money from the donor shall be distributed to the
 39 council of the Girl Scouts of America that is located in the
 40 geographic area where the donor's residence is located.
