## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 7.1-3-3-4; IC 7.1-5-9-4.

**Synopsis:** Beer wholesalers in certain counties. Permits an individual beer wholesaler to hold a beer wholesaler's permit in both Monroe and Jennings counties. (Current law provides that a beer wholesaler may hold a permit in only one county.)

**Effective:** July 1, 1998.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning alcoholic beverages.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 7.1-3-3-4 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 4. ~~Premises Described~~  
3 ~~in Application.~~ (a) The premises to be used as a warehouse by an  
4 applicant shall be described in the application for the permit. The  
5 commission shall not issue a beer wholesaler's permit to an applicant  
6 for any other warehouse or premises than that described in the  
7 application.

8 (b) **Except as provided in subsection (c),** the commission shall  
9 issue only one (1) beer wholesaler's permit to an applicant, but a  
10 permittee may be permitted to transfer his warehouse to another  
11 location within the county, upon application to, and approval of, the  
12 commission.

13 (c) **Notwithstanding subsection (b), the commission may issue to**  
14 **an individual applicant one (1) beer wholesaler's permit for each**  
15 **county having a population of:**

16 (1) **more than one hundred eight thousand nine hundred fifty**  
17 **(108,950) but less than one hundred twelve thousand**

2           **(2) more than twenty-three thousand six hundred fifty**  
3           **(23,650) but less than twenty-three thousand seven hundred**  
4           **(23,700).**

5           SECTION 2. IC 7.1-5-9-4, AS AMENDED BY P.L.51-1994,  
6           SECTION 14, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
7           JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 4. An applicant for a beer wholesaler's permit  
8           shall have no interest in the following:

- 9           (1) A permit to manufacture or to sell at retail alcoholic beverages  
10           of any kind.  
11           (2) **Except as provided in IC 7.1-3-3-4(c)**, any other permit to  
12           wholesale alcoholic beverages.  
13           (3) Through stock ownership or otherwise, in a partnership,  
14           limited liability company, or corporation that holds:  
15           (A) a permit to manufacture or to sell at retail alcoholic  
16           beverages of any kind; or  
17           (B) any other permit to wholesale alcoholic beverages of any  
18           kind.
