

HOUSE BILL No. 1065

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 1-1-11-3.

Synopsis: United States flags at half-mast for Veterans' Day. Requires United States flags flown by an agency or office of the state of Indiana on November 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11 to be at half-mast in honor of America's veterans and urges all persons flying flags on these dates to fly the flags at half-mast.

Effective: July 1, 1998.

HOUSE BILL No. 1065

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning general provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 1-1-11-3 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
2 A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1,**
3 **1998]: Sec. 3. (a) The general assembly declares that in honor of**
4 **veterans who have died in America's armed conflicts, all United**
5 **States flags flown in Indiana on November 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11 of each**
6 **year should be at half-mast.**
7 **(b) Any United States flag flown on November 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11**
8 **of each year by an agency or office of the state of Indiana shall be**
9 **flown at half-mast.**
