

HOUSE BILL No. 1066

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-13-2-123; IC 9-13-2-188.

Synopsis: Sport utility vehicles and vans. Specifies that a van, sport utility vehicle, or other motor vehicle is a passenger motor vehicle and not a truck if it is designed primarily for the transportation of passengers.

Effective: July 1, 1998.

HOUSE BILL No. 1066

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-13-2-123 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 123. (a) "Passenger
3 motor vehicle" means, except as provided in subsection (b), a motor
4 vehicle, **including a van or sport utility vehicle**, designed for carrying
5 passengers. The term does not include a motorcycle, bus, or school bus.

6 (b) For purposes of IC 9-19-10, the term includes buses, school
7 buses, and private buses, and excludes trucks, tractors, and recreational
8 vehicles.

9 SECTION 2. IC 9-13-2-188 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
10 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 188. (a) "Truck" means
11 a motor vehicle designed, used, or maintained primarily for the
12 transportation of property. **The term does not include a van, sport
13 utility vehicle, or other motor vehicle designed primarily for the
14 transportation of passengers.**

15 (b) "Truck", for purposes of IC 9-21-8-3, includes the following:

16 (1) A motor vehicle designed and used primarily for drawing
17 another vehicle and constructed to carry a load other than a part

1 of the weight of the vehicle and load so drawn.
2 (2) A motor vehicle designed and used primarily as a farm
3 implement for drawing plows, mowing machines, and other
4 implements of husbandry.
