

HOUSE BILL No. 1112

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: None (noncode).

Synopsis: School library grants and technology preparation funding. Increases the appropriation to the department of education for distribution to school corporations for: (1) school library printed materials grants in the 1997-1999 biennium; and (2) technology preparation in the state fiscal year 1998-1999.

Effective: July 1, 1997 (retroactive); July 1, 1998.

HOUSE BILL No. 1112

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning education and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1997 (RETROACTIVE)] (a)
2 **There is appropriated from the state general fund to the**
3 **department of education for school library printed materials**
4 **grants, eleven million three hundred thousand dollars**
5 **(\$11,300,000) for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending**
6 **June, 30, 1999. The amount appropriated by this SECTION is in**
7 **addition to the amount appropriated to the department of**
8 **education for school library printed materials grants by**
9 **P.L.260-1997(ss).**

10 (b) **This SECTION expires July 1, 1999.**

11 SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998] (a) **There is**
12 **appropriated to the department of education nine million dollars**
13 **(\$9,000,000) from the state general fund for technology**
14 **preparation (tech prep) distribution, beginning July 1, 1998, and**
15 **ending June 30, 1999. The amount appropriated by this SECTION**
16 **is in addition to the amount appropriated to the department of**
17 **education for tech prep distribution by P.L.260-1997(ss).**
