

HOUSE BILL No. 1135

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-10.1-30.

Synopsis: Student accident insurance. Requires a public school corporation to make coverage under a group policy of student accident insurance available for voluntary purchase by the parents and guardians of the school corporation's elementary and secondary school students.

Effective: July 1, 1998.

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January 8, 1998, read first time and referred to Committee on Insurance, Corporations and Small Business.

HOUSE BILL No. 1135

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning insurance.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-10.1-30 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 1998]:

4 **Chapter 30. Mandatory Offering of Student Accident Insurance**

5 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "policy of student accident**
6 **insurance" means a policy of insurance providing coverage of the**
7 **kind described in Class 1(b) of IC 27-1-5-1 to students enrolled in**
8 **a school corporation on a group basis.**

9 **Sec. 2. (a) A school corporation shall make coverage under at**
10 **least one (1) policy of student accident insurance available for**
11 **purchase by the parents and guardians of the students enrolled in**
12 **an elementary school or high school operated by the school**
13 **corporation.**

14 **(b) The purchase of coverage under a policy referred to in**
15 **subsection (a) must be optional and at the election of the parent or**
16 **guardian of the student.**



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
