

# HOUSE BILL No. 1168

---

## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 9-13-2-111; IC 9-29-2-2.

**Synopsis:** Motor vehicles. Changes the definition of "new motor vehicle" to mean a motor vehicle that either: (1) has not been previously titled and carries a manufacturer's certificate of origin; or (2) has never been transferred to an ultimate purchaser. (Current law requires both conditions to be satisfied.) Provides that the fee for information on records of titles, registrations, and driver's licenses requested and delivered through the Internet is \$1. (Current law sets the fee at \$4.)

**Effective:** July 1, 1998.

# HOUSE BILL No. 1168



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-13-2-111 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 111. "New motor  
3 vehicle" means a motor vehicle:

4 (1) that has not been previously titled under IC 9-17 and carries  
5 a manufacturer's certificate of origin; ~~and~~ **or**

6 (2) that has never been transferred by a manufacturer, distributor,  
7 or dealer to an ultimate purchaser.

8 SECTION 2. IC 9-29-2-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
9 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 2. (a) The fee to obtain information  
10 on titles, registrations, and driver's licenses under IC 9-14-3-5 is four  
11 dollars (\$4) for each record requested. **However, the fee for a record**  
12 **that is requested and delivered through the Internet is one dollar**  
13 **(\$1).**

14 (b) The fee imposed by this section is in lieu of fees established  
15 under IC 5-14-3-8 and does not apply to a law enforcement agency or  
16 an agency of government.
