

HOUSE BILL No. 1169

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 4-30.

Synopsis: Purchase of lottery tickets. Allows a retailer, an employee of the retailer, or a relative living in the same household with a retailer or an employee of the retailer to purchase a lottery ticket generated by an instant ticket vending machine at the premises where the retailer is authorized to sell tickets. Prohibits a retailer from placing an instant ticket vending machine in an area that is accessible to an individual who is less than 18 years of age.

Effective: July 1, 1998.

HOUSE BILL No. 1169

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state offices and administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 4-30-2-3.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 1998]: **Sec. 3.5. "Instant ticket vending machine" means a device**
4 **authorized by the commission to function in an on-line, interactive**
5 **mode with the lottery's central computer system for the purpose of**
6 **issuing lottery tickets and entering, receiving, and processing**
7 **lottery transactions.**

8 SECTION 2. IC 4-30-9-15 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
9 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
10 1, 1998]: **Sec. 15. A retailer may not place an instant ticket vending**
11 **machine in an area that is accessible to an individual who is less**
12 **than eighteen (18) years of age.**

13 SECTION 3. IC 4-30-12-4 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
14 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: **Sec. 4. (a) Except as**
15 **provided in subsection (b), a retailer or an employee of the retailer or**
16 **a relative living in the same household with a retailer or an employee**
17 **of the retailer may not purchase a lottery ticket at the premises where**
