

HOUSE BILL No. 1197

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-3.1-5.

Synopsis: IPS parental involvement compacts. Repeals the Indianapolis Public Schools parental involvement law that: (1) requires at the beginning of each school year that IPS schools, students, teachers, and parents enter a compact containing the expectations of each party toward the other parties to the compact; and (2) provides that foster parents who do not come to the school to affirm and sign the compact are reported to the county office of families and children.

Effective: July 1, 1998.
