DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-16-1-1.

Synopsis: Municipal contracts for license branches. Makes a municipality a "qualified person" with which the bureau of motor vehicles commission may contract for the operation of full or partial service license branches.

Effective: July 1, 1998.

HOUSE BILL No. 1224

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 9-16-1-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.62-1996,
2 SECTION 5, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "qualified person"
4 means any of the following:
5 (1) A motor club that is any of the following:
6 (A) A domestic corporation.
7 (B) A foreign corporation qualified to transact business in
8 Indiana under IC 23-1 or IC 23-17.
9 (2) A financial institution (as defined in IC 28-1-1-3).
10 (3) A new motor vehicle dealer licensed under IC 9-23-2.
11 (4) Other persons, including persons licensed under IC 9-23-2
12 that are not covered by subdivision (3), that the commission
13 determines can meet the standards adopted by the commission
14 under IC 9-15-2-1(7) and the requirements for partial service
15 contractors under section 4.5 of this chapter.
16 (5) A municipality (as defined in IC 36-1-2-11).
