Additions: Whenever a new statutory provision is being enacted (or a new constitutional provision adopted), the text of the new provision will appear in **this style type**. Also, the word **NEW** will appear in that style type in the introductory clause of each SECTION that adds a new provision to the Indiana Code or the Indiana Constitution.

Conflict reconciliation: Text in *this style type* or ~~this style type~~ reconciles conflicts between statutes enacted by the 1997 General Assembly.

HOUSE BILL No. 1279

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning the general assembly.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 2-2.1-1-4 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
2 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 4. ~~Length and Frequency of~~
3 ~~Sessions: Special Session:~~ A special session of the General Assembly,
4 called by the Governor as provided in Article 4, section 9 of the
5 Constitution of the State of Indiana, shall continue for not more than ~~thirty~~
6 ~~(30) session days nor more than~~ forty (40) calendar days following the
7 day upon which it is commenced.

8 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
