DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-12-19.5-0.5.

Synopsis: Tuition exemption. Provides that for purposes of the tuition exemption at state educational institutions provided to the surviving spouse or children of a public safety officer killed in the line of duty, the term "other required fees" includes room and board expenses.

Effective: July 1, 1998.

HOUSE BILL No. 1315

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-12-19.5-0.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: **Sec. 0.5. As used in this chapter,**
4 **"other required fees" includes room and board expenses.**
