

HOUSE BILL No. 1346

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-12-34-6.

Synopsis: Confirmatory drug analysis fund. Establishes the confirmatory drug analysis fund for the purpose of compensating the state department of toxicology established within the Indiana University School of Medicine for conducting confirmatory blood and urine tests for drugs and alcohol as requested by law enforcement agencies, prosecuting attorneys, and other state and local governmental entities. Appropriates \$252,000 to the confirmatory drug analysis fund from the state general fund beginning July 1, 1998, and ending June 30, 2000.

Effective: July 1, 1998.

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HOUSE BILL No. 1346



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning the state department of toxicology and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-12-34-6 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 1998]: **Sec. 6. (a) The confirmatory drug analysis fund is**
4 **established for the purpose of compensating the department of**
5 **toxicology for conducting confirmatory blood and urine tests:**
6 **(1) for drugs and alcohol; and**
7 **(2) as requested by law enforcement agencies, prosecuting**
8 **attorneys, and other state and local governmental entities.**
9 **The fund shall be administered by the department of toxicology.**
10 **(b) Sources of money for the fund consist of the following:**
11 **(1) Appropriations from the general assembly.**
12 **(2) Donations, gifts, and money received from any other**
13 **source, including transfers from other funds or accounts.**
14 **(c) The expenses of administering the fund shall be paid from**
15 **money in the fund.**
16 **(d) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not**
17 **currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same**



1 manner as other public funds may be invested. Interest that
2 accrues from these investments shall be deposited in the fund.
3 (e) Money remaining in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year
4 does not revert to the state general fund.
5 (f) Money in the fund is continuously appropriated to the
6 department of toxicology for the purposes described in subsection
7 (a).
8 SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998] (a) There is
9 appropriated to the confirmatory drug analysis fund established
10 under IC 20-12-34-6, as added by this act, two hundred fifty-two
11 thousand dollars (\$252,000) from the state general fund beginning
12 July 1, 1998, and ending June 30, 2000.
13 (b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2000.

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
