

SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 13 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, delete lines 16 through 17.
2 Page 2, delete lines 1 through 3, begin a new paragraph and insert:
3 **"Sec. 3. "Indian tribe" has the meaning set forth in 25 U.S.C.**
4 **2703(5)."**
5 Page 2, line 5, delete "Land" and insert **"Except as provided in**
6 **section 2 of this chapter, land"**.
7 Page 2, delete lines 7 through 8, begin a new paragraph and insert:
8 **"Sec. 2. The state may enter an agreement with an Indian tribe**
9 **to operate a land based casino in one (1) of the following**
10 **municipalities:**
11 (1) A town:
12 (A) that is located in a county having a population of
13 more than eighteen thousand three hundred (18,300) but
14 less than eighteen thousand five hundred (18,500);
15 (B) having a population of more than two thousand
16 eighty-five (2,085) but less than three thousand (3,000);
17 and
18 (C) in which a majority of the town's citizens voting on
19 a public question vote to allow casino gambling in the
20 town.
21 (2) A town:
22 (A) that is located in a county having a population of
23 more than eighteen thousand three hundred (18,300) but
24 less than eighteen thousand five hundred (18,500);
25 (B) having a population of more than six hundred
26 seventy (670) but less than one thousand (1,000); and
27 (C) in which a majority of the town's citizens voting on
28 a public question vote to allow casino gambling in the
29 town.
30 **Sec. 3. (a) The Indian casino negotiation committee is**
31 **established to negotiate an agreement with an Indian tribe under**
32 **section (2) of this chapter.**
33 (b) The committee consists of the following:

- 1 **(1) One (1) individual appointed by the governor.**
 2 **(2) One (1) member of the senate appointed by the president**
 3 **pro tempore of the senate.**
 4 **(3) One (1) member of the house of representatives appointed**
 5 **by the speaker of the house of representatives.**
 6 **(4) One (1) member of the senate appointed by the legislative**
 7 **leader of a major political party (as defined in IC 3-5-2-30)**
 8 **that is different from the political party of the president pro**
 9 **tempore of the senate.**
 10 **(5) One (1) member of the house of representatives appointed**
 11 **by the legislative leader of a major political party (as defined**
 12 **in IC 3-5-2-30) that is different from the political party of the**
 13 **speaker of the house of representatives.**
 14 **(c) The term of a legislative member of the committee ends on**
 15 **the date the member ceases to be a member of the chamber from**
 16 **which the member was appointed. If a vacancy occurs on the**
 17 **committee, the vacancy shall be filled by the appointing authority**
 18 **making the original appointment.**
 19 **(d) Each legislative member and each lay member of the**
 20 **committee is entitled to receive the same per diem, mileage, and**
 21 **travel allowances paid to individuals who serve as legislative and**
 22 **lay members, respectively, of interim study committees established**
 23 **by the legislative council.**
 24 **Sec. 4. The Indian casino negotiation committee shall do the**
 25 **following:**
 26 **(1) Negotiate an agreement with an Indian tribe permitting**
 27 **the Indian tribe to operate a land based casino in a town**
 28 **described in section 2 of this chapter.**
 29 **(2) Recommend legislation implementing the agreement.**
 30 **SECTION 12. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) This**
 31 **SECTION applies to the following:**
 32 **(1) A town:**
 33 **(A) that is located in a county having a population of**
 34 **more than eighteen thousand three hundred (18,300) but**
 35 **less than eighteen thousand five hundred (18,500); and**
 36 **(B) that has a population of more than two thousand**
 37 **eighty-five (2,085) but less than three thousand (3,000).**
 38 **(2) A town:**
 39 **(A) that is located in a county having a population of**
 40 **more than eighteen thousand three hundred (18,300) but**
 41 **less than eighteen thousand five hundred (18,500); and**
 42 **(B) that has a population of more than six hundred**
 43 **seventy (670) but less than one thousand (1,000).**
 44 **(b) The election board of:**
 45 **(1) a town described in subsection (a)(1); and**
 46 **(2) a town described in subsection (a)(2);**
 47 **shall place the following question on the 1998 primary election**
 48 **ballot in the town in the form prescribed by IC 3-10-9-4:**

- 1 **"Shall an Indian casino be permitted to operate in a**
- 2 **designated casino in either the town of ____ or the town of**
- 3 **____?"**.
- 4 **(c) Notwithstanding IC 3-10-9, a local public question placed**
- 5 **on the ballot in a town under this SECTION may be voted on only**
- 6 **by residents of the town.**
- 7 **(d) Notwithstanding IC 3-12-5, the circuit court clerk of the**
- 8 **county in which a public question is on the primary election ballot**
- 9 **under this SECTION shall certify the results of the public question**
- 10 **to the secretary of state not later than May 19, 1998.**
- 11 **(e) This SECTION expires June 1, 1998."**
- 12 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
