

SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 158 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 3, after line 8, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 5. IC 13-23-11-7, AS AMENDED BY
3 P.L.253-1997(ss), SECTION 16, IS AMENDED TO READ AS
4 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 7. (a) The board shall
5 do the following:
6 (1) Adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 and IC 13-14-9 necessary to
7 carry out the duties of the board under this article.
8 (2) Take testimony and receive a written report at every meeting
9 of the board from the commissioner or the commissioner's
10 designee regarding the financial condition and operation of the
11 excess liability trust fund including:
12 (A) a detailed breakdown of contractual and administrative
13 expenses the department is claiming from the excess
14 liability trust fund under IC 13-23-7-1(5); and
15 (B) a claims statistics report consisting of the status and
16 value of each claim submitted to the fund and claims
17 payments made under IC 13-23-8-1.
18 The testimony and written report under this subdivision shall be
19 provided at every meeting of the board. However, the testimony
20 and written report are not required more than one (1) time during
21 any thirty (30) day period.
22 ~~(2)~~ **(3)** Consult with the department on administration of the
23 underground petroleum storage tank excess liability trust fund
24 established by IC 13-23-7-1 in developing uniform policies and
25 procedures for revenue collection and claims administration of
26 the fund.
27 (b) The department shall consult with the board on administration
28 of the underground petroleum storage tank excess liability trust fund.
29 The consultation must include evaluation of alternative means of
30 administering the fund in a cost effective and efficient manner.
31 **(c) At each meeting of the board, the department shall provide**
32 **the board with a written report on the financial condition and**
33 **operation of the underground petroleum storage tank trust fund**
