**MR. PRESIDENT:**

 21 "SECTION 9. IC 35-48-2-8, AS AMENDED BY P.L.1-1994,  
 22 SECTION 171, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
 23 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 8. (a) The controlled substances  
 24 listed in this section are included in schedule III.  
 25 (b) Stimulants. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in  
 26 another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, or preparation  
 27 which contains any quantity of the following substances having a  
 28 stimulant effect on the central nervous system, including its salts,  
 29 isomers (whether optical, position, or geometric), and salts of such  
 30 isomers whenever the existence of such salts, isomers, and salts of  
 31 isomers is possible within the specific chemical designation:  
 32 (1) Those compounds, mixtures, or preparations in dosage unit  
 33 form containing any stimulant substances listed in schedule II  
 34 which compounds, mixtures, or preparations were listed on April  
 35 1, 1986, as excepted compounds under 21 CFR 1308.32, and any  
 36 other drug of the quantitative composition shown in that list for  
 37 those drugs or that is the same except that it contains a lesser  
 38 quantity of controlled substances (1405).  
 39 (2) Benzphetamine (1228).  
 40 (3) Chlorphentermine (1645).

- 1 (4) Clortermine (1647).  
2 (5) Phendimetrazine (1615).
- 3 (c) Depressants. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in  
4 another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, or preparation  
5 which contains any quantity of the following substances having a  
6 depressant effect on the central nervous system:
- 7 (1) Any compound, mixture, or preparation containing:  
8 (A) amobarbital (2125);  
9 (B) secobarbital (2315);  
10 (C) pentobarbital (2270); or  
11 (D) any of their salts;  
12 and one (1) or more other active medicinal ingredients which are  
13 not listed in any schedule.
- 14 (2) Any suppository dosage form containing:  
15 (A) amobarbital (2125);  
16 (B) secobarbital (2315);  
17 (C) pentobarbital (2270); or  
18 (D) any of their salts;  
19 and approved by the Food and Drug Administration for  
20 marketing only as a suppository.
- 21 (3) Any substance which contains any quantity of a derivative of  
22 barbituric acid, or any salt thereof (2100).
- 23 (4) Chlorhexadol (2510).  
24 (5) Glutethimide (2550).  
25 (6) Lysergic acid (7300).  
26 (7) Lysergic acid amide (7310).  
27 (8) Methyprylon (2575).  
28 (9) Sulfondiethylmethane (2600).  
29 (10) Sulfonethylmethane (2605).  
30 (11) Sulfonmethane (2610).  
31 (12) A combination product containing tiletamine and zolazepam  
32 (Telazol) (7295).
- 33 (d) Nalorphine (a narcotic drug) (9400).
- 34 (e) Narcotic Drugs. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed  
35 in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, or preparation  
36 containing any of the following narcotic drugs, or their salts calculated  
37 as the free anhydrous base or alkaloid, in the following limited  
38 quantities:
- 39 (1) Not more than 1.8 grams of codeine, per 100 milliliters or not  
40 more than 90 milligrams per dosage unit, with an equal or  
41 greater quantity of an isoquinoline alkaloid of opium (9803).  
42 (2) Not more than 1.8 grams of codeine, per 100 milliliters or not  
43 more than 90 milligrams per dosage unit, with one (1) or more  
44 active, nonnarcotic ingredients in recognized therapeutic  
45 amounts (9804).  
46 (3) Not more than 300 milligrams of dihydrocodeinone, per 100  
47 milliliters or not more than 15 milligrams per dosage unit, with  
48 a fourfold or greater quantity of an isoquinoline alkaloid of  
49 opium (9805).  
50 (4) Not more than 300 milligrams of dihydrocodeinone, per 100  
51 milliliters or not more than 15 milligrams per dosage unit, with

- 1 one (1) or more active nonnarcotic ingredients in recognized  
2 therapeutic amounts (9806).
- 3 (5) Not more than 1.8 grams of dihydrocodeine, per 100  
4 milliliters or not more than 90 milligrams per dosage unit, with  
5 one (1) or more active, nonnarcotic ingredients in recognized  
6 therapeutic amounts (9807).
- 7 (6) Not more than 300 milligrams of ethylmorphine, per 100  
8 milliliters or not more than 15 milligrams per dosage unit, with  
9 one (1) or more active, nonnarcotic ingredients in recognized  
10 therapeutic amounts (9808).
- 11 (7) Not more than 500 milligrams of opium per 100 milliliters or  
12 per 100 grams or not more than 25 milligrams per dosage unit,  
13 with one (1) or more active, nonnarcotic ingredients in  
14 recognized therapeutic amounts (9809).
- 15 (8) Not more than 50 milligrams of morphine, per 100 milliliters  
16 or per 100 grams with one (1) or more active nonnarcotic  
17 ingredients in recognized therapeutic amounts (9810).
- 18 (f) Anabolic steroid (as defined in 21 U.S.C. 802(41)(A) and 21  
19 U.S.C. 802(41)(B)).
- 20 (g) The board shall except by rule any compound, mixture, or  
21 preparation containing any stimulant or depressant substance listed in  
22 subsections (b) through (e) from the application of any part of this  
23 article if the compound, mixture, or preparation contains one (1) or  
24 more active medicinal ingredients not having a stimulant or depressant  
25 effect on the central nervous system, and if the admixtures are included  
26 therein in combinations, quantity, proportion, or concentration that  
27 vitiate the potential for abuse of the substances which have a stimulant  
28 or depressant effect on the central nervous system.
- 29 **(h) Any material, compound, mixture or preparation which**  
30 **contains any quantity of Ketamine."**
- 31 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
