DIGEST OF SB 21 (Updated January 22, 1998 12:59 pm - DI 84)

Citations Affected: IC 5-2-12-8.5.

Synopsis: Sex offender registry. Prohibits an offender required to register from petitioning for name change. Requires offender whose name changes due to marriage to report change of name to the criminal justice institute within thirty (30) days.

Effective: July 1, 1998.

SENATE BILL No. 21

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 5-2-12-8.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 1998]: **Sec. 8.5. (a) An offender who is required to register
4 under this chapter may not petition for a change of name under
5 IC 34-4-6.**

6 **(b) If an offender who is required to register under this chapter
7 changes the offender's name due to marriage, the offender must
8 notify the criminal justice institute not more than thirty (30) days
9 after the name change.**
