DIGEST OF SB0341 (Updated January 21, 1998 12:13 pm - DI 51)

Citations Affected: IC 33-19-6-10.

Synopsis: Operating a vehicle while intoxicated. Allows a court to collect an alcohol and drug countermeasures fee when a person operates a vehicle while intoxicated and the person's driving privileges are suspended.

Effective: July 1, 1998.

SENATE BILL No. 341

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 33-19-6-10 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998]: Sec. 10. In each action in
3 which a person is found to have:

4 (1) committed an offense under IC 9-30-5;
5 (2) violated a statute defining an infraction under IC 9-30-5; or
6 (3) been adjudicated a delinquent for an act that would be an
7 offense under IC 9-30-5, if committed by an adult;
8 and the person's driving privileges are suspended by the court **or the**
9 **bureau of motor vehicles** as a result of the finding, the clerk shall
10 collect an alcohol and drug countermeasures fee of two hundred dollars
11 (\$200).

12 SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1998] **IC 33-19-6-10, as**
13 **amended by this act, applies to findings under IC 9-30-5 made after**
14 **June 30, 1998, regardless of when the action was filed.**
