

**CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT
DIGEST FOR SB 167**

Citations Affected: None (noncode).

Synopsis: Constitutional amendment ballot language. Conference committee report for ESB 167. Prescribes the ballot language for two public questions submitting amendments to the Constitution of the State of Indiana to the electorate at the 1998 general election. The proposed amendments to the Constitution of the State of Indiana concern voting rights and the residence of the auditor of state, the secretary of state, and the treasurer of state. (This conference committee report removes all provisions of the bill except those relating to the ballot language for the public questions.)

Effective: Upon passage.

- 5 Delete pages 2 through 12.
- 6 Page 13, delete lines 1 through 10.
- 7 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
