Citations Affected: IC 14-22-11.

Synopsis: Youth exception to hunting license requirement. Conference committee report for ESB 177. Creates an exception to the hunting license requirement for an individual who is less than 13 years of age, does not possess a bow or firearm, and is accompanying an adult who holds a valid hunting license. (The introduced version of this bill was prepared for the natural resources study commission.) (This conference committee report puts the bill back in the form that it was in when it left the senate.)
